JUNE 26, 2012

Present: Supervisor Cianfrini, Councilpersons Veazey, Glor, Kabel and Martin, Town Clerk Haacke, Assessor Flansburg, Tom Carpenter and Jeremy Deleyser of Clark Patterson Lee

Supervisor Cianfrini called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Tom Carpenter then took over the meeting explaining the attached information to the residents of Water District 4.

Town Clerk Haacke explained to the residents that Genesee County Health Department received a grant to offset the well testing charges; therefore there will be no charge to the residents.

Once the floor was open to the public the follow issues were discussed:

There is concern due to the fact that the Water Tank is condemned. Tom Carpenter stated that the Water Tower is for storage and pressure.

The proposed water user then asked where the money is coming from to put up the tank and in what location.

How long will the whole tank project take and what effect will it have on the new districts.

Meters will be provided by the Village for the Districts.

The main concern is the Water Tower; Tom Carpenter stated that the Village is close to purchasing the land and as soon as the land is acquired the Tower will go to bid.

Mr. Carpenter stated that the Tower will only affect pressure on a high usage day.

If the District doesn't get the full grant amount then another Public Hearing will be held for resident approval.

With no further business a <u>motion</u> was made by Councilman Veazey, seconded by Councilman Kabel and carried by unanimous vote to close the public hearing at 8:41 pm.
