The Village has cut the Fire budget once again.
Proposed joint district with Alabama.

Possible split interest with some Alabama members.
Oakfield Fire Department may even investigate its own district.
Village has no reserves for purchase of a new truck.

CIDER SOLAR

Board would really like a timeline for the project.
Supervisor Reding would like someone here every month to report on progress.
Holding back changes to contract and new financial backing.

FOX HOLLOW DEVELOPMENT

Supervisor spoke with Mr. Dilcher; look to know what his next steps are.
Supervisor has spoken to Mr. Dilcher and Mr. Marc Johnson, Mr. Dilcher has proposed a three-phase project; he can begin Phase 1 right now if he chooses. Mr. Dilcher stated that Phases 2-3 are at least 3-5 years down the road.

GCEDC STAMP DATA CENTER
